The Group's financial statements for the financial year ending 31 December 2018 is prepared in accordance with the Singapore Financial Standards (International) ("SFRS(I)") issued by the Accounting Standards Council.

The Group has performed an assessment of the transition options and other requirements of SFRS(I) and has determined that there are no changes to the Group's current accounting policies under the financial reporting standards in Singapore or material adjustment on the initial transition of the new framework except as disclosed below.

Early adoption of SFRS(I) 16 Leases

SFRS(I) 16 is effective for financial year beginning on or after 1 January 2019, with early application permitted if SFRS(I) 16 is adopted.

Significant changes to lessee accounting are introduced under SFRS(I) 16, with the distinction between operating and finance leases removed and assets and liablities recognised in respect of all leases (subject to limited exceptions for short-term leases and leases of low value assets). In this regard, the Group has recognised the JTC leasehold land and lease payable of approximately \$\$2,624,000 as an asset and a liability respectively in the statement of financial position on 1 January 2018.

- 8. A review of the performance of the group, to the extent necessary for a reasonable understanding of the group's business. It must include a discussion of the following:

The Group specialises in the design, fabrication, installation and maintenance of antiricochet ballistic protection systems for firearm shooting ranges and tactical training mockups used by military and law enforcement authorities in Southeast Asia and the Middle East.

Review of the Group's Performance

Revenue

Our revenue decreased by approximately \$\$9.3 million or 65.7%, from \$\$14.1 million in the nine months ended 30 September 2017 ("9M2017") to \$\$4.8 million in the nine months ended 30 September 2018 ("9M2018"). Our revenue in 9M2018 was mainly contributed by maintenance works, whereas in 9M2017, our revenue comprised mainly of (i) installation works for a firearm shooting range project in Southeast Asia and in the Middle East, (ii) Marina One architectural steel project, and (iii) maintenance works.

Project and production costs

Our project and production costs decreased by approximately \$\\$3.6 million or 52.1\%, from \$\\$6.9 million in 9M2017 to \$\\$3.3 million in 9M2018. The decrease was in line with the decrease in revenue and primarily due to lower material, sub-contractor and overhead costs in 9M2018 as fewer projects were undertaken in 9M2018 as compared to 9M2017.

Gross profit and gross profit margin

As a result of the foregoing, our gross profit decreased from \$\$7.2 million in 9M2017 to \$\$1.5 million in 9M2018. Our gross profit margin decreased from 50.8% in 9M2017 to 31.3% in 9M2018. The decline in gross profit margin was mainly due to lesser projects which reduced the cost benefits from economies of scale.

Other operating income

Our other operating income increased by approximately \$\$118,000 or 132.6%, from \$\$89,000 in 9M2017 to \$\$207,000 in 9M2018. The increase in other operating income was mainy due to the increase in foreign exchange gain and grants received from various government agencies.

Employee benefits expenses

Our employee benefits expenses decreased by approximately \$\$0.3 million or 9.6%, from \$\$2.7 million in 9M2017 to \$\$2.4 million in 9M2018. The decrease was primarily due to a reduction in headcount and no salary adjustment for the year.

Depreciation expense

Our depreciation expense remained stable at approximately \$\$1.2 million in 9M2017 and 9M2018.

Other operating expenses

Our other operating expenses decreased by approximately S\$0.1 million or 7.5%, from S\$1.8 million in 9M2017 to S\$1.7 million in 9M2018, primarily due to the decrease in land rental which is recognised as leasehold land in accordance with SFRS(I) 16 Leases.

Finance costs

Our finance costs increased by approximately \$\$81,000 or 32.4%, from \$\$250,000 in 9M2017 to \$\$331,000 in 9M2018. The increase in finance cost was mainly due to increase of the term loan average interest rate from 2.35% in 9M2017 to 2.93% in 9M2018.

Net profit for the period

As a result of the foregoing, we recorded a net loss of approximately \$\\$3.8 million in 9M2018.

Review of the Group's Financial Position

Current assets

Our current assets decreased by approximately S\$6.8 million from S\$20.1 million as at 31 December 2017 to S\$13.3 million as at 30 September 2018. The decrease in current assets was mainly due to the decrease in cash on hand and at bank of approximately S\$4.0 million, which was primarily due to the purchase of treasury shares of approximately S\$1.9 million and payment of dividend of approximately S\$0.6 million for the financial year ended 31 December 2017, and decrease in trade and other receivables of approximately S\$1.9 million, contract work-in-progress of approximately S\$1.1 million, partially offset by an increase in inventory of approximately S\$0.2 million.

Non-current assets

Our non-current assets increased by approximately \$\$2.2 million from \$\$27.4 million as at 31 December 2017 to \$\$29.6 million as at 30 September 2018. The increase in non-current assets was primarily due to the increase in property, plant and equipment of approximately \$\$2.0 million, which was mainly due to the early adoption of \$FRS(I) 16 Leases, and

increase in fixed deposit pledged of approximately \$\$0.4 million, partially offset by a decrease in intangible assets of approximately \$\$0.2 million.

Current liabilities

Our current liabilities decreased by approximately \$\$0.8 million from \$\$2.5 million as at 31 December 2017 to \$\$1.7 million as at 30 September 2018. The decrease in current liabilities was mainly attributable to lower trade and other payables of approximately \$\$0.8 million due to lesser purchases made during the period.

Non-current liabilities

Our non-current liabilities increased by approximately \$\$2.5 million from \$\$12.9 million as at 31 December 2017 to \$\$15.4 million as at 30 September 2018. The increase in non-current liabilities was primarily due to the recognition of land lease payable arising from the early adoption of SFRS(I) 16 Leases of approximately \$\$3.1 million, partially offset by the repayment of bank loans and finance leases of approximately \$\$0.6 million.

Review of the Group's Statement of Cash Flows

Net cash used in operating activities

Net cash used in operating activities was approximately \$\$0.5 million in 9M2018, which was a result of operating cash outflow before movements in working capital of approximately \$\$2.1 million. Working capital inflow amounted to approximately \$\$1.9 million, which was partially offset by interest payments of approximately \$\$0.3 million. The net working capital inflow was primarily due to (i) a decrease in trade and other receivables of approximately \$\$1.8 million; (ii) a decrease in contract work-in-progress of approximately \$\$1.1 million, which was partially offset by a decrease in trade and other payables of approximately \$\$0.8 million and an increase in inventories of approximately \$\$0.2 million.

Net cash from investing activities

Net cash from investing activities was approximately \$\$2.6 million in 9M2018, which was primarily due to a decrease in fixed deposits.

Net cash used in financing activities

Net cash used in financing activities was approximately \$\$3.0 million in 9M2018, which was primarily due to purchase of treasury shares of approximately \$\$1.9 million, dividends payment of \$\$0.6 million, and repayment of bank loans and finance lease of approximately \$\$0.5 million.

The Group continues to pursue opportunities to design and engineer customised training solutions for existing and potential customers as law enforcement related customers respond to the threat of terrorism and extremism. The Group is also actively responding to enquiries and requests for tenders from authorities in Southeast Asia and the Middle East. Notwithstanding the competitive market conditions, the Group remains committed to secure more contracts in both the Southeast Asian and Middle Eastern markets.

In addition, the Group is working to strengthen its partnerships with defence contractors, equipment suppliers and consultants to participate with them either in joint tenders, or collaboration for successful tenders.

In September 2018, Starburst announced that it had entered into a non-binding Memorandum of Understanding with an indirect wholly-owned Singapore subsidiary of a defence specialist company and Beijing CSSCA Technologies Co., Ltd to collaborate on providing live-fire training solutions in China.

The Group is also working with the relevant authorities to expand its portfolio of maintenance service contracts and grow its recurrent revenue base.

Given that a major portion of the Group's business is project-based, the revenue contribution from projects may vary from quarter to quarter, depending on the size and scope of the projects on hand and their completion schedules. Nonetheless, the Group will continue to focus on ensuring effective cost management of its projects and production costs to achieve a sustainable operating performance.
